**How much was a ticket for the “tween decks” / steerage (Zwischendeck)?**

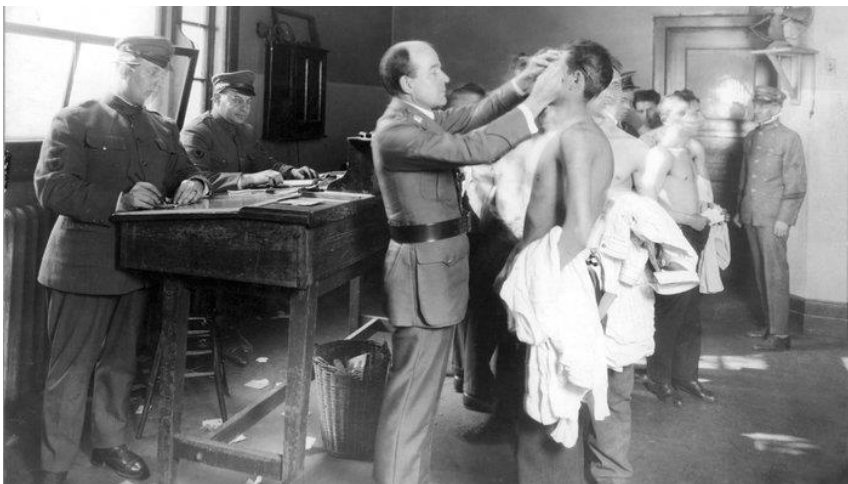
Around 160 Mark (the annual income of a worker)
